Guide to Monuments

1. Site of early BISCOE TOMB (note its position outside)
2. Commemorative War Monument to Arthur Melville Balfour.
3. Plaque: Lamps dedicated to William Earle Biscoe
4. Plaque to Biscoes (ref. tomb outside) also William Earle and Henry Stafford
5. Monument to John Brome - soldier died 23rd July 1558 (one son/eight daughters.) Christopher Brome died 23rd April 1589 (wife Aeleaner)
6. Brass to William Brome 1599, aged 10.
7. Brass to William Brome 1461 (Husband of Joan of Baddesley Clinton.)
8. Plaque to Elizabeth Carey Sandeman.
9. Floor tablet to John Elstone d.1619 & Elizabeth his wife d.1651
10. Brass in memory of nurse Eliza Seary.
11. Plaque in commemoration of William Henry Biscoe/Earle and his wife Anne.
12. Plaque in commemoration of Henry & Anne Tyndale.
13. Oval plaque to Thomas Whorwood d.1771 and Penelope d.1779
14. Altar window in commemoration of George Glas Sandeman d.1868
15. Monument to Thomas George Tyndale 1777 - 1865, his first wife Anne d. 1826 and his widow Anne died 1880
16. Two sets of brass plaques in the floor in front of the altar, including coats of arms.
17. Plaque to Anne Biscoe wife to the Reverend A.R.C Dallas, daughter of Rev. G.T. Tyndale d. 1877
18. Two monuments to the Schutz Family of Shotover.
19. Stone coffin - possibly from late 12th century - image missing.
