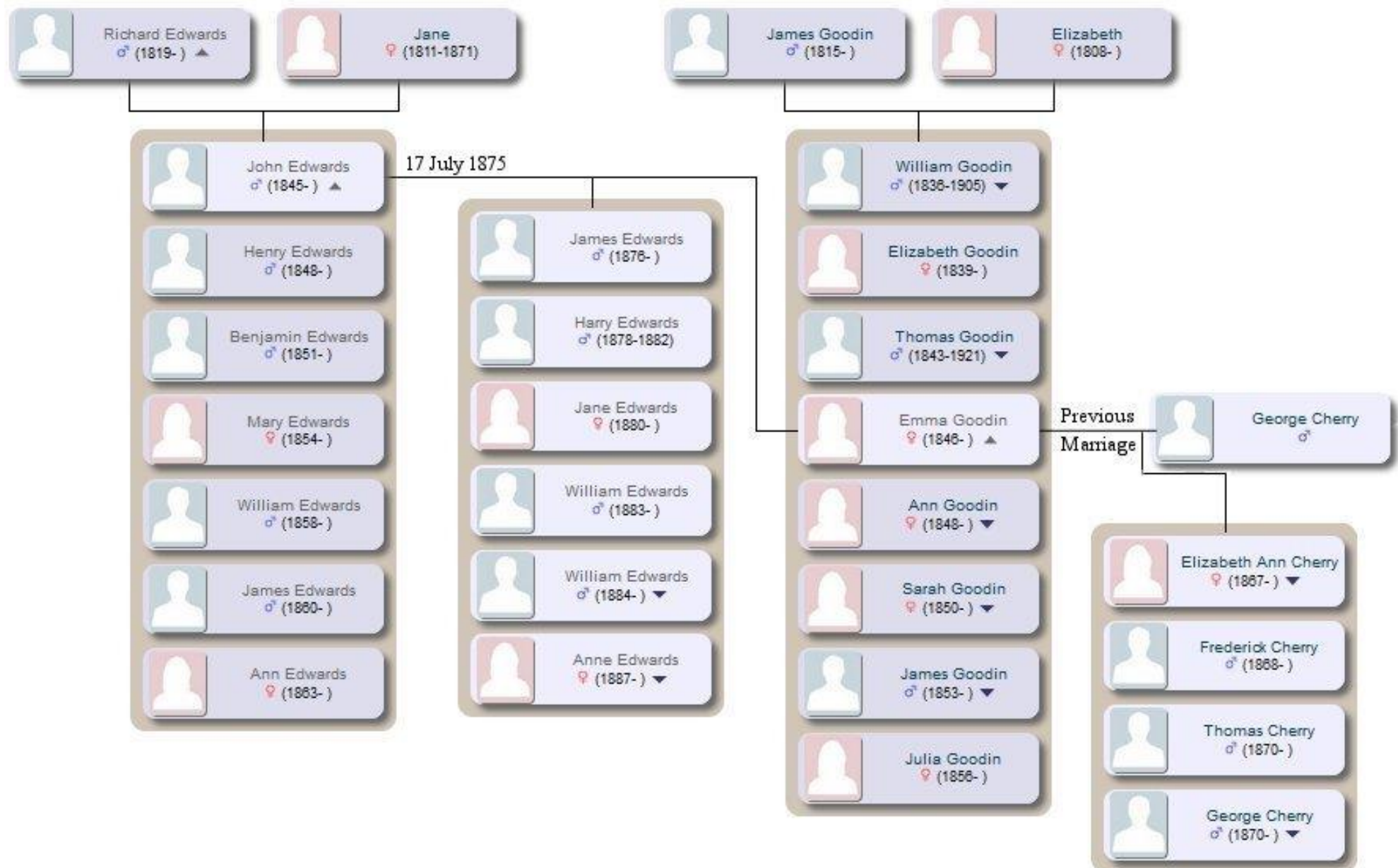
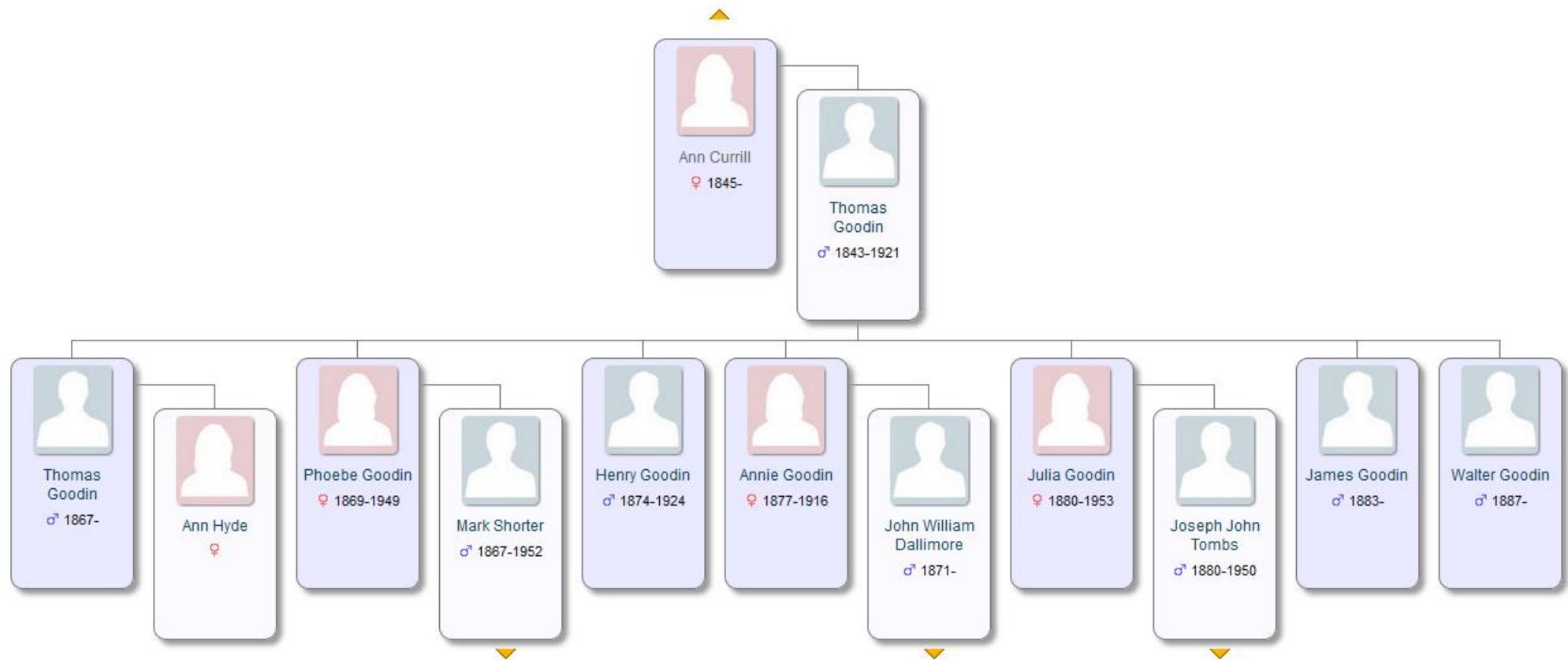


Goodin Family tree



Thomas Goodin (1843-1921) married Ann Currill (1844-1887) and they had four daughters and three sons, none of whom (from our records) carried the name down a further generation. The family lived in Friday Lane and then All Souls Cottage in the High Street.



Thomas and Henry emigrated to Australia. Henry Goodin (born 1874 in Wheatley) served in the Boer War before emigrating to Australia where he became a sheep farmer. Fought with ANZACS in WW1 and was wounded. He returned to England and lived in a cottage in Station Road, next to the fish and chip shop.
