John Rose married Alice Clark (related to Twinings) she lived at Rock House. Kitty Life lived in as companion at Rock House.

Miss Rose Rate Book 1845 (243) owner of part of house (Rateable value £2.1.0.) unoccupied.

In 1821, George Rose mortgaged, 'messuage, slaughter house, buildings, backside garden and plot of land opposite across the road and cottage occupied by Richard Sturges, new erected'. In 1856 he redeemed the mortgage. In 1850 Homestead, stabling bam opposite Manor House conveyed to him.

John (1808-1883) ref. St Aldate's, Oxford. (Butcher) Register of Electors 1862/3 lived in St Thomas', Oxford Freehold house and gardens, Littleworth

Land Tax 1785 Occupier jointly with Mary Davis & Thomas Davison of property owned by Mary Davis, assesses at £-/5/5

Overseers Book, November 1789 Assessed for Poor Rate on Rent of £3/10/=

1784 (Jackson's Oxford Journal) all household furniture & effects to be sold for benefit of creditors

Mary Rose b. 1817 widow of George, the butcher, 1798 - 1879 b. Ickford, living in Church Road,

son William J. b. 1846 unmarried annuitant, son John G b. 1849 unmarried Butcher, daughter Mary

C b. 1851 unmarried annuitant, daughter Annie b. 1859 unmarried annuitant

Rose Bros. Butchers, shop opposite Jessamine Cottage (now 2 Church Road)

Built Wheatley House, then called The Lawn

Married Mary Anne Way b. Ickford 1818-1895 sister of Elizabeth Way (patchwork quilt) ref.

- Richard Rose (1841-1904) Butcher & Farmer 120 acres b. Wheatley, living in Church Road, employed 6 men & 2 boys. Married Catherine b. 1840, Denton, Oxford. Brother, Joseph W b. 1843, Butcher, partner with Richard. Eldest son of George & Mary Anne (Way) 1818-1895
- Sarah Rose (1819-1874) m Peter Moss widower of St Thomas', Oxford 18/08/1834 (Burial Register)
- William Rose (Baconman & Grocer)

-C1785 Land Tax, owner & occupier of property assess £-161%

Overseer Book, November 1789 Assessed for Poor Rate on rent of £4

In 1790 bequeathed to his son William, Yeoman, cottage, stable, carhovel, pigsty & shop. He had a younger son, Thomas. In 1751 bought cottage, house, tenement garden and backside & Bell's Ground. Married 2<sup>nd</sup> Mary, son John died in infancy 1806 (? Died 6/02/1843 aged 75)

- William Henry (Register of electors 1862/3 died Clare Hill. Freehold Cottage, tenant Mary Edwards. (If he is the grandson of William Rose (!) he took out a mortgage on messuage, slaughterhouse, & garden plot. In 1812 he let the house, stable, cart-hovel & pigsty to Richard Casemore of Ickford.
