

Armborough Family (18th and 19th C)

- Thomas Armborough, of Cuddesdon (not in the genealogical records) sold Mott House, in 1773, newly erected in the High Street, to William Biggs for £75
- Thomas Armborough (31.07.1768 — 12.06.1812)
Yeoman of Headington and heir of the late John (William) Armborough (5.11.1731 — 30.06.1796) Gentleman. Lease of 2 cottages and gardens
Land Tax 1785 (see card index for full list of properties)
In 1773, he sold Mott house in the High Street 'newly erected' to William Biggs for £ 75
- Robert Armborough Gentleman b. 27.05.1806 married Leticia Shepherd on 20.12.1820 at Michael's Church, Oxford. Later described as farmer and labourer.
- Edwin Armborough 1832-1851) Annuitant (of independent means)
- Thomas Armborough (12.08.1798 — 15.09.1824) described as a farmer but in 1823 was a servant. (Possibly an easier job due to ill health?) He died in 1824.
- John Armborough (5.11.1753 — 31.06.1796) Index cards of properties owned 1785, cost of land tax & five properties.
 1. Owner of property occupied by John Davis assessed £6/11/07
 2. Owner of property occupied by Richard Griffin assessed £-/16/1 0'/
 3. Owner of property occupied by Thomas Lamburn assessed £-/11/09
 4. Owner of property occupied by William John Mickle assessed £1/05/3'/4
 5. Owner of property occupied by John Boulter & Thomas Holder £-/6/09
- William Armborough (17.06.1804 — 22.06.1834) Register of Electors 1832. Freehold Land. Lived in Wheatley — tenant of Mr John Stacey.

Ann Armborough (nee Price) 60 Head of household, laundress, living in Bell Row

Martha Price Blind sister of Ann Armborough, mangler
