

# Inclosing Lands in the Hamlet and Chapelry of Wheatley, in the Parish of Cuddesdon, in the County of Oxford.

DEREAS there are within the Hamlet and Chapelry Preamble. of Wheatley, in the Parish of Cuddesdon in the County of Oxford, feveral Open and Common Fields, Common Paftures, Commons and Wafte Grounds, and alfo Sixty Acres of Land or thereabouts adjoining the fame, and being Part. and Parcel of the Commonable Lands thereof, commonly called the Cow Common, and which was formerly allotted by a Decree in His Majefty's Court of Exchequer for the Ufe of the Freeholders and Landholders in Wheatley aforetaid, in lieu of their Rights and Interefts in and over a certain Foreft called Shotover in the faid County of Oxford :

And whereas William Henry Ashurst Equire, as Heir at Law of Sir Lord of the William Henry A/hur/t Knight, deceafed, the Truftee named in the Will of Sir John Whalley Smythe Gardiner Baronet, deceafed, is Lord of the Manor of Wheatley aforefaid :

And whereas Gilbert Jackfon, Doctor in Divinity, as Impropriator, Impropriis entitled to certain Glebe Lands lying in the faid Common Fields, 188. and

Manor.

and alfo to all the Great Tythes arifing, growing, and payable within *Wheatley* aforefaid, except the Tythes of Hay and Grafs:

Vicarial Tythes. And whereas the Right Reverend the Lord Bithod of Oxford for the Time being is feifed of or entitled to the Rectory of *Cuddefdon* in the faid County of Oxford, with the Chapelry of *Wheatley* aforefaid annexed, and in Right of the faid Rectory to the Tythes of Hay and Grafs, and to all the Vicarial or Small Tythes arifing, renewing, or happening within *Wheatley* aforefaid:

Other Proprictors. And whereas Sir James Whalley Smythe Gardiner Baronet, the Warden and the College of the Souls of all faithful People deceased of Oxford, and William Davis their Lessee, the Principal and Scholars of the King's Hall and College of Brazen-nofe in Oxford, and Thomas Harper, Jumes Harper, and Sufanna Williams, their Lessees, William Juggins, and divers other Persons, are feifed and possified of or otherwise interested in the faid Open and Common Fields, Common Pastures, Commons and Waste Grounds lying within Wheatley aforefaid, and the faid Commonable Land adjoining the fame:

And whereas an Act, passed in the Forty-first Year of the Reign of His prefent Majesty King GEORGE the Third, intituled, "An " Act for confolidating in One Act certain Provisions usually infert-" ed in Acts of Inclosure, and for facilitating the Mode of proving " the feveral Facts usually required on the passing of fuch Acts:

And whereas the faid Lands and Grounds of the feveral Proprietors of the faid Open Fields and Common Paftures lie intermixed and difperfed in fmall Pieces or Parcels, and are inconveniently fituated, and as well as the faid Commons and Wafte Grounds and Commonable Lands, in their prefent Situation are incapable of any confiderable Improvement, and it would be advantageous to the feveral Perfons interefted therein if the fame were divided, allotted, and inclofed: BUT as fuch Divition, Allotment, and Inclofure cannot be effectuated without the Aid and Authority of Parliament;

### May it therefore pleafe Your MAJESTY,

That it may be Enacted; and be it Enacted by the KING's Most Excellent MAJESTY, by and with the Advice and Confent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this prefeat 188. Parliament Parliament affembled, and by the Authority of the fame, That Richard Davis, of the Grove in the Parifh of Afton Rowant in the County of Oxford, and John Davis, of Bloxham in the fame County, Gentlemen, and their Succeflors to be nominated and appointed in manner hereinafter mentioned, fhall be and they are hereby appointed Commiflioners for valuing, dividing, allotting, and inclofing the faid Open and Common Fields, Common Paftures, Commons and Wafte Grounds in Wheatley aforefaid, and Commonable Land adjoining the fame, according to the Rules, Orders, Provifions, and Directions in the faid recited Act contained (except fo far as they are hereby varied or altered) and according to fuch other Rules, Orders, Provifions, and Directions as are hereinafter expressed and contained, and for otherwise putting this Act in execution.

AND, for obviating the Delays and Inconveniences which might Appointarife by any Difference of Opinion between the faid Commiffioners Umpire, touching any of the Matters and Things to be done in purfuance of this Act; BE it further Enacted, That William Bufhnell, of Afton Tirrold in the County of Berks, Gentleman, fhall be and he is hereby appointed to act as an Umpire concerning the Premifes; and in cafe of any fuch Difference of Opinion between the faid Commiffioners as aforefaid, the fame fhall be referred to and determined by the faid William Bufhnell, whofe Judgment and Determination therein fhall be deemed and taken to be the Judgment and Determination of the faid Commiffioners.

Provided always, and be it further Enacted, That no Perfon Umpirete fhall be capable of acting as an Umpire in the execution of this or take an Oath. the faid recited Act, until he fhall have taken and fubfcribed an Oath in the Form or to the Effect following (that is to fay);

I do fwear, That I will faithfully, impartially, and The Oath.
"honeftly, according to the beft of my Skill and Judgment,
"execute and perform the feveral Trufts, Powers, and
"Authorities vefted and repofed in me as an Umpire, by
"Virtue of an A& paffed in the Forty-ninth Year of the
"Reign of King GEORGE the Third, intituled [Here fet forth
"the Title of this A&] according to Equity and good
"Confcience, and without Favour or Affection, Prejudice
"or Partiality to any Perfon or Perfons whomfoever.

" So help me GOD."

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Which Oath the faid Commissioners or either of them are and is hereby authorized and required to administer to such Umpire, and the faid Oath, so taken and subscribed by the faid Umpire, shall be annexed to and enrolled with the Award of the faid Commissioners, and a Copy of the Enrolment thereof shall be admitted as legal Evidence.

Appointment of new of Commiffioners and Umpire.

And be it further Enacted, That when and fo often as either of the faid Commissioners, or the faid Umpire hereinbefore named or to be appointed in manner hereinafter mentioned, shall die or refuse to act, or become incapable of acting as a Commissioner or Commissioners, or Umpire, for the Purposes of this or the faid recited Act, then and in every fuch Cafe a new Commissioner or Commillioners, or Umpire, not being in any Manner interefted in the faid Division or Allotment and Inclosure, or any Part thereof, fhall and may be nominated, elected, and appointed in manner following; (that is to fay) if the faid Richard Davis shall die, refufe to act, or become incapable of acting as aforefaid, it shall be lawful for the faid Sir James Whalley Smythe Gardiner, his Heirs or Afligns, by Writing under his or their Hand or Hands, to nominate and appoint fome other fit Perfon, not interefted in the faid Division, Allotment, or Inclosure, to be a Commissioner in the room or flead of the faid Richard Davis, and fo from Time to Time as often as any Commissioner to be appointed by the faid Sir James Whalley Smythe Gardiner, his Heirs or Afligns, fhall die, refuse to act, or become incapable of acting ; and if the faid John Davis shall die, refuse to act, or become incapable of acting as aforefaid, it shall be lawful for the major Part in Value of the Proprietors of the faid Lands and Grounds (except the faid Sir James Whalley Smythe Gardiner and his Heirs and Affigns) or to or for the refpective Attornies or Agents of fuch Proprietors who fhall be prefent at a public Meeting or refpective public Meetings to be holden for that Purpofe in the Chapel at Wheatley aforefaid, in purfuance of public Notice to be given in one or more of the weekly News-papers published at Oxford, and by Writing to be affixed to the principal outer Door of the Chapel at Wheatley aforefaid Twenty-one Days at leaft before every fuch Meeting (which Notice the other Commissioner, or the Clerk who shall ' have been chofen and appointed by the faid Commissioners, are and is hereby authorized and required forthwith to give). by Writing under their Hands, to elect and appoint another Commiffioner in the room and ftead of the faid John Davis fo dying, refusing to act, or become incapable of acting, and fo from Time

Time to Time as often as any Commissioner or Commissioners to be appointed by the faid Proprietors shall die, refuse to act, or become incapable of acting; and if the faid William Bufhnell, or any Umpire to be appointed as hereinafter mentioned, thall die, refuse, or become incapable to act, then and in every fuch Cafe a new Umpire, not interefted in the faid Division or Allotment and Inclofure, thall and may be chofen in the flead of every Umpire fo dying, refusing, or becoming incapacitated, by a Majority in Value of the Proprietors of the faid Lands and Grounds, who by themfelves, or their refpective Attornies or Agents, fhall be prefent at any Meeting to be appointed for that Purpole in manner aforefaid, not excepting the faid Sir James Whalley Smythe Gardiner. his Heirs or Affigns ; and in cafe the Perfon or Perfons refpectively hereinbefore enabled to appoint a Commissioner or Commissioners, or Umpire as aforefaid, thall refute or neglect to appoint fuch Commiffioner or Commiffioners, or Umpire, in the place or fread of any other Commissioner or Umpire who shall die, refuse to act, or become incapable of acting as aforefaid, for the fpace of Twenty-eight Days next after any fuch Vacancy fhall happen, then and in every fuch Cafe, and as often as the Cafe fhall happen, the faid Commiffioners, or the furviving or remaining Commissioners, as the Cafe may be, fhall and may by Writing under their or his Hands or Hand nominate and appoint another Commissioner or Umpire, not interested in the faid Division or Allotment and Inclosure, in the room and flead of every Commissioner or Umpire fo dying, refusing to act, or becoming incapable of acting, whole Place thall not be filled up by the Perfon or Perfons refpectively enabled to appoint as aforefaid ; and every fuch new Committioner and Umpire to to be appointed thall have the fame Powers and Authorities for putting this Act and the faid recited Act into execution, in all Refpects whatfoever, as any Commissioner or Umpire had or was invested with by virtue of this Act.

And be it further Enacted, That Robert Fifter Gills, of Fare-surveyer. ham in the County of Hants, Land Surveyor, fhall be and he is hereby appointed the Surveyor for executing the feveral Powers vefted in him by the faid recited Act and this Act, and fhall be fubject to the Controul and Directions of the faid Commissioners; and in cafe of his Death, Incapacity, or declining to act, then and in either of fuch Cafes the faid Commissioners thall and may appoint fuch other Perfon as they fhall think proper to be their Surveyor.

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'Yers to Com-.mdioners, &c.

And be it further Enacted, That the Commifficeners and Umpirewho fhall act in the execution of the Powers and Authorities hereby vetted in them, fhall be paid the Sum of Three Pounds and Three Shillings each, and no more, for each Day they fhall be employed therein (Days of travelling to and from their Houfes included); and that at all their Meetings the faid Commifficeners and Umpire fhall defray their own Expences, except the Money they fhall pay to Servants, and for the Ufe of the Room or Rooms in which fuch Meetings thall be held.

Notice of Meetings.

And be it further Enacted, That the faid Commissioners shall and they are hereby required to caufe Notice to be given in Writing under their Hands, to be advertifed in the aforefaid News-paper or News-papers, and to be affixed on One of the principal outer Doors. of the Chapel of Wheatley aforefaid, of the Time and Place of the First and other Meetings of the faid Commissioners for executing the Powers hereby vefted in them, at leaft Twenty-one Days before any fuch Meeting (Meetings by Adjournment only excepted), and that all Meetings for executing the Powers of this Act thall be held at fome convenient Place in Wheatley aforefaid, or within Six Miles of the Chapel thereof ; and in cafe at any fuch appointed or adjourned Meeting only One of the faid Commissioners shall attend, fuch Commillioner may adjourn the fame in fuch Manner and to fuch Place within the faid Six Miles as he fhall think proper and con--venient, not exceeding Twenty-one Days after fuch Meeting, and the faid Commiffioner making fuch Adjournment is hereby required to -give Notice thereof in Writing to the abfent Commissioner; and in cafe no one of the faid Commissioners shall be prefent at any fuch Meeting, then it shall be lawful for their Clerk to adjourn any fuch Meeting, and appoint the fame to be held at the fame or any other Place on any future Day, not exceeding Fourteen Days from the Day of Adjournment, and thall give timely Notice thereof to the Commissioners.

Other Notices how to be given. Provided always, and be it Enacted, That all other Notices neceffary or requifite to be made and given by the faid Commiffioners thall be fo-made and given by Writing affixed upon One of the principal outer Doors of the faid Chapel of *Wheatley*, or by Advertifements in the faid News-paper or News-papers published at Oxford aforefaid.

Commissiononers to fetthe Disputes, arife between any of the Parties interested or claiming to be in-188. terefied

terefted in the faid Division, Allotment, and Inclosure, touching or concerning the Right to the Soil of the faid Commons and Wafte Grounds, or any Part or Parts thereof, or touching or concerning the refpective Shares, Rights, and Interefts which they or any of them thall have or claim to have in the fame, or touching or concerning any other Matter or Thing relating to the faid Division, Allotment, and Inclosure, it shall be lawful for the faid Commissioners and they are hereby authorized and required with all convenient fpeed to examine into, hear, and determine the fame: Provided always, that nothing in this Act contained thall authorize the faid Committioners to determine the Title iles. to any Mefluages, Cottages, Lands, or Hereditaments whatfoever.

And be it further Enacted, That in cafe the faid Commissioners Power to fhall, upon the Hearing and Determination of any Claim or Claims, affects Colle. Objection or Objections, to be delivered to them in purfuance of this Act or the faid recited Act, fee Caufe to award any Cofts, it shall be lawful for the faid Commissioners and they are hereby empowered, upon Application made to them for that Purpofe, to fettle, affets, and award fuch Cofts and Charges as they fhall think reafonable, to be paid to the Party or Parties in whofe Favour any Determination of the faid Commissioners shall be made, by the Perfon or Perfons whofe Claim or Claims, Objection or Objections shall be thereby difallowed or over-ruled; and in cafe the Perfon or Perfons who shall be liable to pay fuch Costs and Charges shall neglect or refuse to pay the same on Demand, then and in every fuch Cafe it shall be lawful for the faid Committioners and they are hereby required and authorized, by Warrant under their Hands and Seals directed to any Perion or Perions whomfoever, to caufe fuch Cofts and Charges to be levied by Diffrefs and Sale of the Goods and Chattels of the Perfon or Perfons fo neglecting or refuling to pay the fame, rendering the Overplus (if any) upon Demand to the Perfon or Perfons whofe Goods and Chattels fhall have been to diffrained and fold, after deducting the Cofts and -Charges attending fuch Diffrefs and Sale.

Provided always, and be it further Enacted, That in cafe any Allowing Perfon or Perfons interefted or claiming to be interefted in the faid Parties to try intended Divition, Allotment, and Inclofure, thall be diffatisfied with their Rights any Determination of the faid Commissioners or Umpire touching or concerning any Claim or Claims of the Right to the Soil of the faid Commons and Grounds, or of any Rights of Common, or other Rights or Interefis in, over, or upon the Lands and Grounds hereby directed to be divided, allotted, and inclosed, or any Part thereof,

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at shall be lawful for the Perfon or Perfons fo diffatisfied to proceed to a Trial at Law of the Matter fo determined by the faid Committioners or Umpire at the then next or the following Affizes to be holden for the faid County of Oxford, and for that Purpofe the Perfon or Perfons, who fhall be diffatisfied with the Determination of the faid Commissioners or Umpire, shall cause an Action to be brought upon a feigned Iffue against the Perfon or Perfons in whofe Favour fuch Determination shall have been made, within Six Calendar Months next after fuch Determination of the faid Committioners or Umpire; and the Defendant or Defendants in fuch Action or Actions shall and he, she, or they is and are hereby required to name an Attorney or Attornies, who fhall appear thereto or file Common Bail, and accept One or more Iffue or Iffues, whereby fuch Claim or Claims and the Right or Rights thereby infifted on may be tried and determined, fuch Iffue or Iffues to be fettled with the proper Officer of the Court in which the faid Action or Actions thall be commenced, in cafe the Parties thall differ about the fame; and the Verdict or Verdicts which shall be given in such Action or Actions shall be final, binding, and conclusive upon all and every Perfon and Perfons whomfoever, unlefs the Court wherein fuch Action or Actions thall be brought thall fet afide fuch Verdict or Verdicts, and order a new Trial to be had therein, which it thall be lawful for the faid Court to do, as is usual in other Cafes; and after fuch Verdict or Verdicts shall be obtained, and not fet alide by the Court, the faid Commissioners shall and they are hereby required to act in conformity thereto, and allow or difallow the Claim or Claims thereby determined according to the Event of fuch Trial or Trials; provided alfo, that the Determination of the faid Commiffioners or Umpire touching fuch Claim or Claims to or Right or Rights or Interefts in, over, or upon the Lands and Grounds hereby directed to be divided, allotted, and inclosed, or any Part thereof, which shall not be objected to, or being objected to the Party or Parties objecting not caufing fuch Action or Actions at Law to be brought and proceeded in as aforefaid, thall be final, Inclofare not binding, and conclusive upon all Parties; provided alfo, that no Difference or Suit touching the Matters aforefaid, fhall impede or delay the Committioners in the execution of the Powers vefted in them by this Act, but the Division, Allotment, and Inclosure hereby directed to be made fhall be proceeded in notwithftanding Action not to fuch Differences or Suits ; provided also, that if any of the Parties Death of the in any Action or Actions to be brought in purfuance of this Act shall die pending the fame, fuch Action or Actions shall not abate by reafon thereof, but shall be proceeded in as if no fuch Event had happened.

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Provided always, and be it further Enacted, That if any Perfon In cafe of or Perfons in whole Favour any fuch Determination as aforefaid Parties befhall have been made, and against whom any fuch Action or Actions fore Actions might have been brought if living, fhall die before any fuch Action frame to be or Actions shall have been brought, and before the Expiration of the carried on Time hereinbefore limited for bringing fuch Action or Actions, it and defendfhall be lawful for the Perfon or Perfons, Bodies Politic or Corpo-Names. rate, who might have brought fuch Action or Actions against the Perfon or Perfons fo dying, to bring the fame within the Time fo limited as aforefaid against fuch Perfon or Perfons as if actually living, and to ferve the Clerk to the faid Commissioners with Process for commencing fuch Action or Actions in the fame Manner as the Party or Parties might have been ferved therewith if living; and it. shall therein also be incumbent on the Heir or Heirs, or other Perfon or Perfons who fhall claim the Benefit of fuch Determination as aforefaid, to appear and defend fuch Action or Actions in the Name or Names of the Perfon or Perfons fo dead, and Proceedings fhall be had therein in the fame Manner as if fuch Perfon or Perfons had been actually living, and the Rights of all Parties shall be equally bound and concluded by the Event of fuch Action or Actions.

Provided alfo, and be it further Enacted, That nothing in this Perfons in Act contained thall extend to enable the faid Commissioners to de- to be molefttermine any Right between any Parties contrary to the Poffeffion of ed without any fuch Parties, except in Cafes of Encroachments; but in cafe due course of Law. the faid Commissioners shall be of Opinion against the Rights of the Perfon or Perfons fo in pofferition, they shall forbear to make any Determination thereupon until the Polefion fhall have been given up by or recovered from fuch Perfon or Perfons by Ejectment or other due courfe of Law.

Provided alfo, and be it further Enacted, That nothing in this Perfons in Act contained shall extend to enable the faid Commissioners to de- to be molesttermine any Right between any Parties contrary to the Poffelion of ed without any fuch Parties, except in Cafes of Encroachments; but in cafe due courfe of Law. the faid Commissioners shall be of Opinion against the Rights of the Perfon or Perfons fo in pofferition, they shall forbear to make any Determination thereupon until the Podeffion shall have been given up by or recovered from fuch Perfon or Perfons by Ejectment or other due courfe of Law.

And be it further Enacted, That in the meantime, and until Courfe of fuch Division and Allotment shall be made as aforefaid, all the Pafture, Tillage, and other Lands hereby intended to be divided, allotted, and inclosed, shall be stocked with such Cattle, and fown by the refpective Owners or Occupiers thereof with fuch Sorts of Corn, Grain, Grafs, and other Seeds, and fhall be kept, ordered, and continued in fuch courfe of Management, Tilth, and Hufbandry, as the faid Commissioners shall by any Writing or Writings under their Hands in that Behalf, to be affixed on the principal outer Door of the Chapel of Wheatley aforefaid, order, direct, and appoint, any Ufage or Cuftom of flocking, tilling, or fowing to the contrary notwithstanding; and if any Person or Persons shall fow or manage any of the faid Tillage Lands contrary to the Order of

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the faid Commissioners, he, she, or they shall forfeit and pay any Sum not exceeding Five Pounds an Acre for every Acre fo tilled, fown, or managed, and fo in proportion for a lefs Quantity than an Acre thereof, to be recovered by any Perfon or Perfons who fhall inform and profecute for the fame in manner prefcribed by the faid recited Act touching the Recovery of Penalties and Forfeitures, together with reafonable Cofts.

**Rights** of Common to be extin-

And be it further Enacted, That it fhall be lawful for the faid Commissioners at any Time hereafter, when and so often as they in guifhed, &c. their Judgment shall think fit, by Notice for that Purpofe under their Hands, to be affixed on the principal outer Door of the Chapel of Wheatley aforefaid, to fufpend or totally extinguish all or any Part of the Rights of Common over the Lands and Grounds hereby intended to be divided, allotted, and inclosed ; and from and after fuch Notice given, all fuch Rights of Common over the faid Lands and Grounds, as by fuch Notice fhall be directed or declared to be fufpended or extinguished, shall ceafe and be fufpended for fuch Time, or extinguished in fuch Manner as the Commissioners shall in and by fuch Notice direct; and if after fuch Sufpenfion or Extinguishment of any fuch Rights of Common, any of the faid Owners or Occupiers shall turn or permit his, her, or their Cattle or Sheep to departure or feed on any of the Lands and Grounds fo difcharged and freed from Right of Common, then and as often as the Cafe shall fo happen it shall be lawful for any other of the faid Owners or Occupiers to diffrain all or any fuch Cattle or Sheep being upon any fuch Lands or Grounds contrary to fuch Notice, and to impound and keep the fame impounded until the Perfon or Perfons fo offending fliall pay to the Perfon or Perfons diffraining a Sum not exceeding Ten Shillings for each Head of Cattle, and Five Shillings for each Sheep fo diffrained ; and in cafe the fame, together with all Cofts and Charges, fhall not be paid before the next Meeting of the faid Commiffioners after fuch impounding, the faid Commiffionersare hereby authorized and empowered, upon Proof of fuch Offence or Offences having been committed, and Non-payment of the Penalty or Penalties incurred, to caufe the Cattle or Sheep fo diftrained, or fuch of them as they fhall think neceffary, to be fold for raiting and paying the Penalty or Penalties fo incurred as aforefaid, together with the Cofts and Charges attending every fuch Diffrefs and Sale, rendering the Overplus (if any) upon Demand to the Owner or Owners of fuch Cattle or Sheep.

Stopping up eld Roads.

And be it further Enacted, That the faid Commissioners shall and may turn or abate and ftop up any ancient Carriage Road or Way, 188. Roads 11 1

Roads or Ways, or any private Footway or Path, Footways or Paths in, through, upon, or over any of the inclosed Lands or Grounds within Wheatley aforefaid, where they shall judge it requisite or expedient, whereof fuch Notice shall be given of a Day to be appointed by them to receive Objections as is in the faid recited Act directed and required in the Cafe of fetting out Roads, and obferving the Directions of the faid recited Act as to the obtaining the Concurrence and Order of Two Juffices of the Peace previous thereto, and fubject to an Appeal to the Quarter Seffions in fuch Manner and under fuch Regulations as in the faid recited Act is mentioned,

And be it further Enacted, That it shall and may be lawful for Power to fell any Perfon or Perfons having any Effate or Effates within Wheatley aforefaid, at any Time after the paffing of this Act, to fell and difpole Property of his, her, or their refpective Eftates, Rights of Common, or other giving the Rights or Interefts in or upon any of the faid Lands and Grounds hereby directed to be divided, allotted, and inclosed feparate and apart from the Property in Right of which fuch Perfon or Perfons is, are, or fhall be refpectively entitled to fuch Rights of Common or other Rights or Interefts as aforefaid.

And beit further Enacted, That no Pastures or Grass Lands, Part Grass Lands of the faid Lands and Grounds hereby directed to be divided, allotted, and inclosed, shall from and after the passing of this Act, and before the flaking out of the Allotments to be made in purfuance of this Act, be ploughed, broke up, or converted into Tillage or Garden Ground ; and that every Proprietor, Occupier, or Tenant who fhall fo plough, break up, or convert into Tillage or Garden Ground any fuch Pafture or Grafs Land, fhall forfeit and pay for every Acre of fuch Pafture or Grafs Land fo ploughed, broke up, or converted into Tillage or Garden Ground any Sum not exceeding Ten Pounds, and fo in proportion for a greater or lefs Quantity than an Acre, to be recovered by any Perfon or Perfons who shall inform and profecute for the fame, in manner prefcribed by the faid recited A& touching the Recovery of Penalties and Forfeitures, together with reafonable Cofts.

And be it further Enacted, That it shall be lawful for the faid Satisfaction Commissioners and they are hereby required to fettle and afcertain what Recompence shall be made or paid to the respective Occupiers. whether Owners or not, of any of the faid Open Arable Lands, for the Value of any Crop or Crops, or for any Clover or other Laver of artificial Grafs growing on any of the faid Lands or Grounds to be divided, allotted, inclosed, or exchanged in purfuance of or by virtue

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for Crops

virtue of this or the faid recited Act, or for any Tillage, Manure, or. Preparation for a Crop or Crops on any of the faid Lands and Grounds refpectively allotted on which fuch Crop or Crops or Layer. of artificial Grafs shall be growing, or wherein fuch Tillage, Manure, or Preparation fhall be made or laid as aforefaid, and by Writing or Writings under their Hands in that Behalf to order the Payment of fuch Recompence and Satisfaction to be made as they shall deem reafonable by the Perfon or Perfons who shall have the Benefit of fuch Crop or Crops or Layer of artificial Grafs, or fuch Tillage, Manure, or Preparation; and in cafe fuch Perfon or Perfons fhall neglect or refufe to pay or make fuch Recompence or Satisfaction accordingly within the fpace of Fourteen Days after the fame fhall have been ordered and demanded, then it fhall be lawful for the faid Commissioners and they are hereby required, by Warrant under their Hands and Seals directed to any Perfon or Perfons whomfoever. to caufe the fame to be levied by Diffrefs and Sale of the Goods and Chattels of fuch Perfon or Perfons fo refusing or neglecting to pay or make fuch Recompence or Satisfaction as aforefaid, rendering the Overplus (if any) upon Demand to fuch Perfon or Perfons refpectively, after deducting the Cofts and Charges of taking and making every fuch Diftrefs and Sale; and in cafe fuch Diftrefs cannot be taken as aforefaid, it fhall be lawful for the faid Commillioners, or any Perfon authorized by them for that Purpofe, to enter into and upon fuch Lands as aforefaid, or any Part thereof refpectively, and receive the Rents, Iffues, and Profits thereof refpectively, until thereby and therewith or otherwife the full Amount of fuch Recompence and Satisfaction, and all Cofts, Charges, and Expences occafioned by or attending fuch Entry upon and receiving the Rents and Profits of the fame Premifies, fhall be refpectively fully paid and fatisfied; which Sum or Sums of Money fo to be levied, received, or raifed thall, after difcharging fuch Cofts, Charges, and Expences as aforefaid, be applied in making fuch Recompence and Satisfaction to the Perion or Perfons to whom it fhall belong as aforefaid, rendering the Overplus (if any) on Demand to the Owner or Proprietor, Occupier or Occupiers, or fuch other Perfon or Perfons as the Cafe may be.

Allotments for Materials to repair Roads, &c,

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And be it further Enacted, That the faid Commissioners shall and may and they are hereby required, before any other Allotment is made in pursuance of this Act, to set out and appoint one or more Piece or Pieces, Parcel or Parcels of Land or Ground, Part or Parts of the Lands and Grounds hereby intended to be divided, allotted, and inclosed in *Wheatley* aforefaid, in such convenient Place or Places as they shall think proper, for getting Stone, Gravel, or other

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other Materials for repairing the Roads and Highways within Wheatley aforefaid, and for the Ufe of the Proprietors and Owners of Effates within *Wheatley* aforefaid, according to their refpective Rights and Privileges (if any fuch they have); and fuch Parcels of Land shall be vested in the Surveyor or Surveyors of Highways of Wheatley aforefaid for the Time being upon Truft, and for the Purpofes in the faid recited Act and in this Act mentioned.

And be it further Enacted, That the faid Commissioners shall Allotment to and they are hereby authorized and required in the next place to the Lord of the Manor fet out, allot, and award unto the Lord of the Manor of Wheatley for the Right aforefaid, for and in lieu of his Right to the Soil of all Wafte of Soil. Lands within the faid Manor, fuch Parts, Share, and Proportion of the Lands and Grounds hereby intended to be divided, allotted, and inclosed, as in the Judgment of the Commissioners making the fame (Quantity, Quality, and Situation confidered) shall be deemed a full Recompence and Satisfaction of and for all the Right of Soil which fuch Lord now hath or might or of right ought to have had in fuch Wafte Lands if this Act had not been made.

And be it further Enacted, That the faid Commissioners shall and Allotments they are hereby authorized and required to fet out, allot, and to be made for Glebe appoint unto and for the faid Gilbert Jackfon, his Heirs and Affigns, and Common in lieu of his Globe Lands within Wheatley aforefaid and Right of Rights. Common to him belonging, fuch Piot or Plots, Parcels or Quantities of the Lands and Grounds by this Act intended to be divided, allotted, and inclosed as thall in the Judgment of the faid Committioners be a full Equivalent and Compensation to the faid Gilbert Jackjon, his Heirs and Affigns, for fuch Glebe Lands and Right of Common.

And be it further Enacted, That the faid Commissioners shall Allotments and they are hereby authorized and empowered to fet out and allot in lieu of Great and unto and for the faid Gilbert Jackjon, his Heirs and Afligns, as Im- Small propriator as aforefaid, and the faid Lord Bithop of Oxford and his Tythes. Succeffors, for and in lieu of their feveral and refpective impropriate and vicarial Tythes hereinbefore mentioned, yearly iffuing, arifing, or renewing out of all and every the tytheable Parts of the faid Open and Common Fields, Common Paftures, Commons, and Wafte Grounds, and Commonable Land hereby directed to be divided, allotted, and inclosed, and for and in lieu of the Tythes of fuch Homefteads, Gardens, Orchards, and other ancient inclofed Lands and Grounds within Wheatley aforefaid, as are fub-188. D ject

ject to Tythes, fuch Plot or Plots, Parcel or Parcels of the faid Open and Common Fields, Common Paftures, Commons, or Wafte Grounds, and Commonable Land, as (Quantity, Quality, and Situation confidered) thall contain or be equal in Value to Onefifth Part of the Arable Lands (including the Sward, Balks, and Heads of and intermixed with the faid Arable Lands) and to Oneninth Part of all Meadow, Pafture, or Greenfward Ground within or adjoining to Wheatley aforefaid, which are fubject to the Payment of Tythes (after deducting the Land or Ground fet out for the Roads, and the Allotments hereinbefore directed to be fet out as aforefaid); all which Plots or Allotments fhall be in full Satisfaction and Difcharge of and for the faid feveral and refpective Great and Small Tythes ifluing, ariting, and renewing from and out of the faid Open and Common Fields, Common Paftures, Commons, and Wafte Grounds, and Commonable Land, and out of the faid Homefteads, Gardens, Orchards, and other ancient inclofed Lands and Grounds within Wheatley aforefaid (Mortuaries, Eafter Offerings, and Surplice Fees only excepted).

Subdivision to be made. Provided always, and be it further Enacted, That when and as foon as conveniently may be after the faid Plot or Plots, Allotment or Allotments thall have been fo fet out and allotted to and for the faid Gilbert Jackfon, his Heirs and Afligns, and the faid Lord Bithop of Oxford and his Succeffors as aforefaid, for and in lieu of their feveral Great and Small Tythes refpectively, as hereinbefore mentioned, they the faid Committioners thall and they are hereby required to fubdivide, aflign, and allot the faid Plots or Allotments laft mentioned unto and between the faid Gilbert Jackfon, his Heirs and Afligns, and the faid Lord Bithop of Oxford and his Succeffors as aforefaid, in proportion to their feveral and refpective Rights and Interefts in the Tythes in lieu whereof the faid Plots or Allotments are hereby before directed to be awarded and made, and in proportion to the Value of fuch Great and Small Tythes refpectively.

And be it further Enacted, That the Lands and Grounds fo to be fet out, allotted, and awarded for and in lieu of and as a Compenfation and Satisfaction for fuch Great and Small Tythes refpectively as aforefaid thall be limited, fettled, and affured to, for, and upon fuch and the fame Eftates, Ufes, Limitations, Intents, and Purpofes as fuch Great and Small Tythes refpectively thall frand limited, fettled, and affured, and be fubject and liable to at the Time of making fuch Allotments refpectively.

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And

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And be it further Enacted and Declared, That all fuch of Declaring the faid Lands and Grounds as fhall have been tilled or ploughed Arable at any Time within Twenty Years laft, fhall for the Purpofes Lands. of this Act be deemed and be taken to be Arable Land.

And be it further Enacted, That in cafe there are any other Proprietors Homefteads, Gardens, Orchards, or ancient Inclofures within not having Wheatley aforefaid, which are tytheable as aforefaid, the refpective Open Field Landto com-Proprietors whereof fhall not be entitled to Lands or Property penfate for in the Lands or Grounds fo directed to be divided and inclosed as Tythes to aforefaid, equal to the Value of One-fifth Part of fuch Homefteads, paythe Value Gardens, Orchards, or ancient Inclofures as are Arable, and of One- wards Exninth Part of the Refidue thereof, the faid Commissioners are pences. hereby authorized and empowered to fet out for the faid Gilbert Jackfon, his Heirs and Afligns, as Impropriator as aforefaid, and the faid Lord Bithop of Oxford and his Succeffors, fuch Parcel or Parcels of the faid Lands and Grounds hereby directed to be divided and inclosed, as shall be equal to Onefifth Part of fuch Homefteads, Gardens, Orchards, or ancient Inclofures as are Arable, and to One-ninth Part of the Refidue thereof; and the faid Proprietors of fuch Homefteads, Gardens, Orchards, or ancient Inclofures, shall pay or cause to be paid unto such Person or Persons, and at such Time or Times as the faid Commissioners shall direct or appoint, such Sum and Sums of Money as the faid Commiffioners thall deem and adjudge to be a full Recompence and Satisfaction for the Land hereinbefore directed to be fet out and allotted, in lieu of the Tythes of fuch Homefteads, Gardens, Orchards, or ancient Inclofures refjectively; which Sum or Sums of Money fhall be applied towards or in part Difcharge and Satisfaction of the Charges and Expences incident to or attending the obtaining and patting of this Act and carrying the fame into execution; and in cafe any Perfon or Perfons liable to pay fuch Sum and Sums of Money as aforefaid, fhall neglect or refuse to pay the fame within the Time to be limited by the faid Commissioners for Payment thereof, to fuch Perfon or Perfons as they fhall appoint to receive the fame, then and in fuch Cafe the faid Sum and Sums of Money thall be raifed, levied, and recovered, together with the Cofts and Charges of raifing, levying, and recovering the fame, in fuch and the fame Manner as the other Expences of this Act are to be raifed, levied, and recovered: Provided always, that in in cafe any Surplus thall remain after fuch Charges and Expences fhall have been paid as aforefaid, then fuch Surplus thall be divided and apportioned between the feveral Perfons interested in the faid Lands

And be it further Enacted, That the Allotment or Allotments to be fet out, allotted, and awarded unto and for the faid *Gilbert Jackfon* his Heirs and Afligns, as Impropriator as aforefaid, by virtue and in purfuance of this Act, fhall be near or adjoining to the Farm-houfe and Homeftall of the faid *Gilbert Jackfon* at *Wheatley* aforefaid; and that the Allotment or Allotments to be iet out, allotted, and awarded unto and for the faid Lord Bifhop of Oxford and his Succeffors as aforefaid, fhall adjoin or lie as near as conveniently may be to *Cuddefdon* aforefaid.

And be it further Enacted, That the faid Commiffioners fhall and they are hereby authorized and required in the next place to fet out, divide, and allot the Remainder of all the faid Open and Common Fields, Common Paftures, Commons, and Wafte Grounds hereby intended to be divided, allotted, and inclosed, unto and amongst the feveral Perfons, Bodies Politic or Corporate, Owners, Proprietors, and Perfons interefted therein, in fuch Quantities, Shares,

Tythes to be paid to fuch Time as Committioners thall appoint.

Provided always, and be it further Enacted by the Authority Committionaforefaid, That nothing in this Act or the faid recited Act con- ers not to tained shall extend or be construed to extend to give the faid allot the Cottagers Commissioners or any of them Power to divide, allot, or inclose Common. any Part of a certain Piece or Parcel of Land containing Twenty Acres or thereabouts, commonly called the Cottagers Common, and which was formerly allotted by the faid Decree in His Majefty's Court of Exchequer for the Ufe of the Cottagers and poor Inhabitants of Wheatley aforefaid," in lieu of their Rights and Interefts in and over the faid Foreft called Shotover in the County of Oxford.

And be it further Enacted, That when and fo foon as the faid Oliections to Commissioners thall have afcertained the refpective Shares, Rights, and Interests of the faid Proprietors in the Lands and Grounds to mined by be inclosed by virtue of this Act, and also the respective Shares and Proportions by them proposed to be allotted to fuch Proprietors refpectively in lieu thereof, they the faid Commissioners fhall give Notice in manner aforefaid of fome convenient Time and Piace when and where all Proprietors and Perfons interefted may perufe a Schedule of fuch intended Allotments, and a Map or Plan whereon the fame fhall be fet out and delineated, and may have and receive a Copy of fuch Schedule fo far as the fame relates to fuch Proprietors respectively; and in regard that some Persons may upon Perufal of the faid Schedule and Infpection of fuch Map or Plan be diffatisfied with their intended Allotments, the faid Commillioners thall give Notice of One Meeting at the leaft to be held by them for receiving Complaints and Objections against fuch intended Allotments; and for hearing and determining all fuch Complaints and Objections, and their Determination in the Premifes being reduced into Writing and figned by them, fhall be binding and conclusive upon all Parties.

Provided always, and be it further Enacted, That if any Perfon or Perfons hath or have fold, or contracted or agreed to fell, or thall at any Time before the faid Commissioners thall have executed their Award fell or contract or agree to fell his, her, or their Right or Intereft or Property in, over, or upon the faid Open and Common Fields, Common Paftures, Commons, and Wafte Grounds, or any Part thereof, to any other Perfon or Perfons, then and in every fuch Cafe it shall be lawful for the faid Commissioners and they are hereby required to make an Allotment or Allotments of Land unto the Vendee or Vendees, Purchafer or Purchafers in fuch Sales, Contracts, or Agreements refpectively, and to his, her, or their refpective Heirs, Executors, Administrators, and Afligns, for and in refpect of fuch Right or Rights, Intereft or Interefis, and Property fo fold and contracted and agreed to be fold as aforefaid ; and every fuch Vendee and Purchafer, and his and her Heirs, Executors, Administrators and Afligns, shall and and may, from and after the execution of the faid Award, hold and enjoy the Land fo to be allotted to him, her, or them refpectively as aforefaid, in the fame Manner to all Intents and Purpofes as the Vendor or Vendors in every fuch Sale, Contract or Agreement, might, could, or of right ought to have held and enjoyed the fame in cafe fuch Sale, Contract, or Agreement had not been made, or fuch Right, Intereft, or Property had been vefted in fuch Vendor or Vendors refpectively at the Time of making the faid Award as aforefaid, but fubject neverthelefs to all Incumbrances aflecting the fame, and to the Charges and Expences of the faid Divition, Allotment, and Inclofure, and alfo to the Tythes due or to become due in refpect of the fame.

And be it further Enacted, That the Charges and Expences Expences incident to and attending the obtaining and paffing of this Act, of the Adand of the furveying, dividing, and allotting the Lands and Grounds hereby authorized to be divided and allotted, and the preparing and enrolling of the Award or Inftrument of the faid Commissioners, and all other Writings and Inftruments to be executed by the faid Commissioners in purfuance of this Act, and of fencing the faid Allotments for Materials, Glebe, and Tythes, and all other the neceflary Expences in, about, and concerning the execution of this Act, which are not herein otherwife directed to be borne, payed, and defrayed, shall from Time to Time be born, paid, and defrayed by the feveral Proprietors (except the faid Gilbert Jackfon, his Heirs and Afligns, and the faid Lord Bifhop of Outford and his Succeffors as aforefaid, in refpect of their Glebo and Tythes as aforefaid) to whom the Lands and Grounds directed to be divided and inclosed thall be allotted, and by fuch Perfon or Perfons who fhall be entitled to or poffeffed of fuch of the prefent Homefteads, Orchards, Gardens, inclofed Lands and Grounds, as are not poffeffed of any Lands or Grounds within the faid Open and Common Fields, Common Paftures, Commons and Wafte Grounds hereby directed to be divided, allotted, and inclosed, out of which any Allotment or Allotments can be made in lieu of Tythes in the Manner before directed, or to whom the Lands or Tenements fo exchanged thall belong, in proportion to their refpective Property and Interefts, to be fettled and determined from Time to Time by the faid Commissioners in fuch Manner, and to be paid and payable to fuch Perfon or Perfons, and at fuch Days and Times as the faid Commissioners in and by any Writing or Writings under their Hands, or by the faid Award, fhall from Time to Time order and direct; and if fuch Cofts and Charges thall not be paid within the Time or Times by the faid Commissioners to be appointed for F 188. Payment

Payment thereof, then and in fuch Cafe the fame fhall and may be levied and recovered in the Manner directed by the faid recited Act :

This Act not to affect Wills, &c.

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Provided always, that nothing in this Act contained shall extend or be confirued to extend to revoke, make void, alter, or annul any Will or Settlement, or to prejudice any Perfon or Perfons having any Right or Claim of Dower, Jointure, Portion, Debt, or Incumbrance out of, upon, or affecting any of the Lands and Grounds to be divided, allotted, or exchanged by virtue of the faid recited Act or of this Act, or any Part thereof, but that each and every Proprietor fhall ftand and be feifed of the feveral Lands and Grounds to be allotted to or exchanged with him or her as aforefaid, to fuch and the fame Ufes, and fubject to fuch and the fame Wills, Jointures, Rents, and Charges, and no other, as the Lands, Grounds, and Hereditaments whereof fuch Proprietor was feifed or poffeffed at or immediately before the figning and fealing of the faid Award, or for which or in refpect whereof fuch Allotments or Exchanges shall be made would have been subject to, charged with, or affected by in cafe this Act had not been made.

Supplemental Infirument may be executed by the Commiffioners for fupplying Omiffions in certainCafes.

And be it further Enacted, That where the Proprietor or Proprietors of any Lands, Grounds, or other Hereditaments which shall be allotted by virtue of this or the faid recited Act, shall hold their Lands, Grounds, or Hereditaments by different Tenures or for different Eftates, or under different Titles, the faid Commissioners shall, upon the Request of fuch respective Proprietors in Writing under their Hands, afcertain and diffinguish the Lands, Grounds, or other Hereditaments held by each of fuch Tenures for each of fuch Effates refpectively, and fhall accordingly in their Award fet out and diftinguish diftinct and leveral Allotments for fuch refpective Lands or other Hereditaments; and where from the want of neceffary Information before the faid Commiffioners, or from any other Caufe, their Award shall omit diferiminating, as hereinbefore is mentioned, fuch Titles, different Effates and different Tenures, and within Twelve Calendar Months after the making of the faid Award Requeft shall be made to the faid Commiffioners by any Perfon or Perfons interefied, by Writing under his or their Hand or Hands, to have fuch Omifion fupplied by a feparate Inftrument or Inftruments, then and in every fuch Cafe the faid Commissioners are hereby authorized to do every thing necessary for fupplying fuch Omiffion, and to far as that Purpofe shall require to examine Witneffes, and in every other Refpect to proceed and act as if the Award had not been made; and when they fhall have obtained what 188. they

they think fufficient Information, they are hereby authorized, by any Deed under their Hands and Seals, to afcertain and diftinguifh the Difference of Tenures, Effates, and Titles refpectively, and accordingly to make diftinct and feveral Allotments for the fame; and every fuch feparate Inftrument, after having been duly executed by the faid Commissioners, shall have the fame Effect as if it was contained in the faid Award, and fhall be delivered unto the Perfon or Perfons upon whole Request the faid Omifion shall have been fupplied, or the Perion or Perfons to whom the Cuftody of the Deeds and Writings concerning the Title to the Premifies in queftion shall in the Opinion of the faid Commissioners most properly belong for the Time; and all Expences which thall be reafonably incurred in and about any fuch Supplementary Inftrument as aforefaid, fhall be payable by the Perfons who fhall have fo requefted the faid Commissioners as aforefaid, or by his, her, or their Heirs, Executors, or Administrators.

And be it further Enacted, That it shall not be lawful for any sheep not to Perfon or Perfons, for the fpace of Five Years next after the be kept on execution of the faid Award, to keep or departure any Sheep or new Allot-Lambs in or upon any of the Allotments to be made by virtue of certain Pethis ACt, unlefs the Perfon or Perfons keeping fuch Sheep or Lambs riod. fhall at his or their own Expence effectually and fufficiently fence off or guard and keep properly fenced off and guarded the Quickfet Hedges or other live Fences of the Proprietor or Proprietors whole Allotment or Allotments may adjoin to the Inclofures where fuch Sheep or Lambs fhall be fo kept, fo as to prevent any Damage being done to fuch Quickfet Hedges.

And be it further Enacted, That if any of the faid Proprietors, Interest to be or any other Perfon, fhall advance any Money for the Purpofe of paid for Modefraying the Expences of obtaining and paffing this Act, or for vanced. carrying the fame into execution, every fuch Proprietor and other Perfon fhall be repaid the fame with Intereft at the Rate of Five Pounds per Centum per Annum out of the First Monies that shall be raifed for defraying fuch Expence by virtue of this Act.

And be it further Enacted, That the Award to be made by the Award to be faid Committioners, when enrolled in manner directed by the faid deposited. recited Act, shall be deposited in a Tin Box, and shall be kept in the Chapel of Wheatley aforefaid.

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And

Accounts to be laid before Two Juffices.

And be it further Enacted, That once at leaft in every Year during the execution of this Act, fuch Year to be computed from the Day of paffing thereof, the faid Commissioners shall and they are hereby required to make a true and just Statement or Account of all fuch Sums of Money by them received and expended, or due to them for their own Trouble and Expences in the execution of this Act; and fuch Statement or Account, when fo made, together with the Vouchers relating thereto, shall be by them laid before any Two or more of His Majesty's Justices of the Peace for the faid County of Oxford, to be by them examined and balanced : and such Balance shall be by such Justices stated in the Books of Accounts to be kept in the Office of the Clerk to the faid Commissioners, and no Charge or Item in such Accounts shall be binding on the Parties concerned, or valid in Law, unless the fame shall have been duly allowed by such Justices.

Appeal.

And be it further Enacted, That if any Perfon or Perfons, or any Parifh, Townfhip, or Precincts, fhall think him, her, or themfelves aggrieved by any thing done in purfuance of this or the faid recited Act, then and in every fuch Cafe, except as to fuch Claims, Matters, and Things as are hereinbefore directed or authorized to be tried, fettled, or determined by the Verdict of a Jury, or where any of the Claufes or Provisions of the faid recited Act or of this Act fhall express that the fame fhall be final and conclutive, he, the, or they may appeal to any General Quarter Seffions of the Peace to be holden for the faid County of Oxford, within Four Calendar Months next after the Caufe of Complaint thall have arifen, fuch Perfon or Perfons giving Fourteen Days previous Notice to the faid Commissioners of his, her, or their Intention to appeal; and the Juffices in fuch General Quarter Seffions are hereby authorized and required to hear and determine the Matter of every fuch Appeal, and to make fuch Order therein and award fuch Cofts as to them in their Difcretion thall feem reafonable, and by their Order or Warrant to levy the Cofts which fhall be fo awarded by Diftrefs and Sale of the Goods and Chattels of the Party or Parties liable to pay the fame, rendering the Overplus (if any) on Demand to the Owner or Owners of fuch Goods and Chattels, after deducting the reafonable Charges of fuch Diftrefs and Sale ; which Determination of the faid Juffices fhall be final - and conclusive to and upon all the Parties concerned, and shall not be removed or removable by Certiorari, or any other Writ or Procefs whatfoever, into any of His Majefty's Courts of Record at *Weftminfler* or elfewhere.

Sabing

Saving always to the KING's Moft Excellent MAJESTY, His General Heirs and Succetiors, and to all and every other Perfon or Perfons, Body or Bodies Politic, Corporate or Collegiate, his, her, and their Heirs, Succeffors, Executors, and Administrators (except the feveral Perfons to whom any Allotment or Allotments fhall be made in purfuance of this Act, for and in refpect of fuch Rights and Intereits as are hereby meant and intended to be barred, deftroyed, and extinguished, and all Perfons respectively claiming under them or in Remainder after them) all fuch Right, Title, and Intereft as they, every, or any of them could or ought to have had and enjoyed in, to, and out of the Lands and Grounds hereby directed to be divided, allotted, and inclosed, in case this Act had not been made.

And be it further Enacted, That this Act fhall be printed by the Act to be Printer to the KING's Most Excellent Majesty, and a Copy King's Printhereof fo printed shall be admitted as Evidence thereof by all ter, and a Copy fo Judges, Juffices, and others.
