MUNT FAMILY

Where did all the Munts go?

A definition first. A 'dead-end' is a tree which has no issue from a known male Munt heir at its bottom. There may be such issue but, if there is, we currently have no information.

The Munt trees start with John Munt died 1564 (Munt tree 01) and Isaac Munt b. 1594 supplementary (Munt tree 01a).

and then go through Thomas Munt b. 1576 and Francis Munt b. 1639 (Munt tree 02).

to Francis Munt b.1700 (Munt tree 03), then to Thomas Munt b. 1729, Francis Munt b. 1735 and Isaac Munt b. 1738, considered after the square bracket next paragraph.

[Ignoring Richard Munt b. 1725 (Munt tree 04-01) a completely different branch of the family with no forebears and Isaac Munt b. 1793 as the only descendant through George Munt b. 1828 down to a 'dead-end' of no known Munt-named descendants.]

First, Thomas Munt b. 1729 (Munt tree 04-02) takes us to only to Thomas Munt b. 1753 (Munt tree 05-01) which goes to Thomas Munt b. 1777 and then via Stephen Munt b. 1802 to George Munt (b. 1842) and thence to George Munt b. 1863; William b. 1869 and Charles Munt b. 1875; all of whom are 'dead-ends'.

Second, Francis Munt b. 1735 (Munt tree 04-03) is another 'dead-end'.

Third, Isaac Munt b. 1738 (Munt tree 04-04) takes us down to Isaak Munt b. 1775, George Munt b. 1780, and James Munt b. 1784, considered below. These are the only ongoing not 'dead-ends'.

The first of these three, Isaak Munt b. 1775 goes via Isaak Munt b. 1797, to John Munt b. 1831, and thence to Henry Munt b. 1863, a 'dead-end' and Charles Munt b. 1877 another 'dead-end'.

The second of these, George Munt b. 1780 goes down to Henry Munt b. 1806; George Munt b. 1808; John Munt b. 1825; and Isaac Munt b. 1827. The first and third are 'dead-ends'. George Munt b. 1808 goes down to George Munt b. 1835; James Munt b. 1837; and William Munt b. 1849, all of whom are 'dead-ends' While Isaac Munt b. 1827 goes down to William Munt b. 1851; Isaac Munt b. 1868; and James Munt b. 1874, all also 'dead-ends'.

So, all these trees end with no ongoing known male Munt heir. There are six un-connected trees later in this document, all of which have no known ongoing male Munt heir.

Is there a reason for this? Nothing is obvious with the trees that lead nowhere. Each tree has approximately the same number of males and females at their end. But there seems a certain reluctance for many of the male heirs to have children, perhaps because this family were mainly labourers and most of the 19th century had an over-supply of labourers, so not a good environment to spawn yet more labourers. Then, there was infant mortality which may have meant that many males did not survive long, although many branches of the family made up for this by having a very large number of children.

As examination of the genealogical records of the 252 Munt family members on the website will show, there are very few Munt records beyond birth dates of the 1920s and 1930s. Was this an effect of a change of attitude after the Great War? But, as we know and after being the most populous family name in Wheatley, there are now very few, if any, Munts in Wheatley and Littleworth.

Further information can be gleaned from the 1911, 1921 and 1939 censuses related to the foregoing Munt trees as follows

Addition in Munt names from 1911 to 1921

Where Munts lived in 1910/11 with husband's employment if known. All in 1921 census unless otherwise stated

Albert Munt b. 1870 (I2420) and Mary Munt (I2436), 39 Littleworth –still there in 1921 and 1939, died 1950. Labourer. On William Munt 1869 tree

Charles Munt b. 1827 (I2423) and Edith Munt b. 1880 (I2437), Clayton Cottage 32 Church Road – probably still there in 1921. Traction engine driver. On William Munt 1849 tree.

Harriet Munt (widow) b. 1871 (I2252), Robbins Row. Dress maker. Presumed died before 1921

Henry Munt b. 1863 (I2417) and Elizabeth Munt b. 1863 (I2865), Kings Cottage, High Street – Probably still there in 1921. Coal carter. On Henry Munt 1863 tree

Herbert Munt b. 1869 (I2249) and Sarah Munt b. nk (I3810), Prospect Cottage 11 Westfield Road – probably still there in 1921. Market gardener. James Munt 1837 tree

Isaac (Isaak) b. 1865/6 (I964) and Annie (Anne) b. nk (I2435), 19 Littleworth – Isaac still there in 1921. Traction engine driver. Annie not in 1921 census, see 3 above.

James Munt b. 1837 d. 1922 (I2190) (widower), site of 75/77 High Street. Market gardener

James Munt b. 1874 (I21) and Annie Munt b. 1869 (I22), 25 Littleworth – James Munt still there in 1921. Market gardener. Annie Munt not in 1921 census, see 2 above.

James Munt and Eliza Munt b. 1861 (I2416), site of current parade of shops. Market gardener John Munt b. 1859 (I1133) and Fanny Munt b. 1864 (I1129), 29 Littleworth – Fanny Munt still there in 1921. Agricultural labourer

Joseph Munt b. 1874 and Ada Munt. May have been tenants of Iliffe Cottage, 45 Church Road or have lived in Crown Road. Labourer. Not in 1921 census. Not added to master document.

Martha Munt (widow, nee Shorter b. 1842 I26)), Brook House, 20 Littleworth. Still alive in 1921

Thomas Munt, Chapman's Yard. Woodman. Presumed died before 1921, see 4 above

Thomas Munt b. nk (I2452) and Emma Munt b. nk (I2453). Site of 69-71 High Street. Market gardener. Children Connie Munt b. nk, Ethel Mary Munt b. nk, d. 1982, Alice Evelyn Munt b. 1904.

William Munt b. 1869 (I2) and Agnes Munt b. 1874 and d. 1967 (I3), 4 Littleworth. Labourer

- William Munt and Alice Munt. Cannot be identified on genealogical list. 13 Bell Lane. Brick labourer. Not in 1921 census
- William Munt b. 1849 (I36) and Rosina Munt b. 1848 (I42), 11 Bell Lane, Labourer. William Munt not in 1921 census, presumed died, see 5 above

There are 50 Wheatley Munt names on the 1921 census, but only 22 names on the 1939 excluding, of course, redacted names of people born after 1922.

On the 1939 census or record, there are the following 22 names (with Genealogical I number) with dates of birth and (1939 census number) as follows:

Joseph Munt 24/7/1873 (I2325) in Old London Road (wife Sarah presumed deceased) (23) On George Munt 1842 tree

William Munt 5/4/1878 and Alice Munt 11/7/1886 in London Road (62). Not on Genealogical list or 1921 census, so a newcomer.

Isaac Munt 25/7/1898 and Louisa Munt (28/1/1906) in London Road (68). Not on Genealogical list or 1921 census, so a new comer.

Leslie Ewart Munt 21/6/1911 (I2445) and Elsie Munt 13/2/1902 (I2446) at Hillside Church Road (168). On Henry Munt 1863 tree. Leslie Munt died in 1978.

Andrew Munt 2/10/1893 (d. 1944) (I7) and (Harriet) Mary Tipping (d. 1970) (I9) 17/8/1892 at Holloway Corner Church Road (169). On Isaac Munt 1868 tree. In 1921 census.

Albert Munt 8/5/1870 (I2420) and Mary Anne Munt (I773) 21/6/1878) at Clayton's Yard, Church Road (172). On John Munt 1831 tree. In 1921 and 1939 censuses. Albert Munt died in 1950

Frederick Munt 6/5/1906 (I10) and Susan Clara Hawes (29/9/1906) (I907) in Bell Lane (188). On Isaac Munt 1868 tree. They were married on 27 July 1928 and had a son Brian Munt (I2392) birth date nk..

Richard Munt 2/11/1902 (I11) and Evelyn Munt (1/2/1908) (I908) in Bell Lane (215). On Isaac Munt 1868 tree. No descendants noted

Fanny Munt 10/12/1869 (I1129) and her son Isaac Munt 11/3/1895 (I27) living in The Lane next to Cricketers (369). On John Munt 1825 tree. Fanny (Dover) had married John Munt (b. 1859), who had died (date nk), but Fanny Munt was still alive as was Isaac Munt who died in 1979 and who had served In Royal Warwickshire Regiment.

Isaac Munt b. 1866 living on Ladder Hill at Station View (379). Also on 1921 census. Not the one b. 4/10/1868 (I5) on Isaac Munt 1868 tree. So, a newcomer

Richard James Munt b. 2/10/1896 (I20) and Daisy Munt 2/6/1892 (I23) on Ladder Hill at Station View (382). On James Munt 1874 tree. Daisy on 1921 census also. Their son James Walter Munt born in July 1923 and died in 2002 would have been redacted.

Lines of enquiry are therefore needed for any children born to the following

William Munt 5/4/1878 and Alice Munt 11/7/1886 lived in London Road in 1939.

Isaac Munt 25/7/1898 and Louisa Munt (28/1/1906) lived in London Road. in 1939.

Andrew Munt (died 1944) and Harriet Mary Munt (nee Tipping and died 1970)) lived on the corner of Holloway Road and Church Road.

Albert Munt (died 1950) lived with his wife Mary Munt at Clayton's Yard in Church Road.

Brian Munt, son of Frederick Munt and Susan Clara Munt (nee Hawes).

Isaac Munt b. 1866 and lived at Station View in 1939.

James Walter Munt, b. July 1923 and died in 2002.

William Munt and Alice Munt, who lived at 13 Bell Lane. Brick labourer.


Edgar Munt (b. 1888) was a chimney sweep in 1945 after having worked in the Littleworth brickworks







But before considering the three continuing trees, another branch of the family with a starting point of Richard Munt, b. 1725 also comes into being as Munt tree 04-01





Munt tree 04-02 From Munt tree 03, branch Thomas b. 1729










Isaac Munt, 1793-1864, was probably the family member who was allocated pew number 50 in the south aisle of St. Mary's church in 1856 (record 1083). He is also, on the 1803 Pay List of the Cuddesdon Company of Volunteers (with also Joseph and George, more likely to be held in Cuddesdon records rather than Wheatley).

Henry Munt tree b. 1806






George is continued as George Munt b. 1835 tree, James is continued as James Munt b. 1837 tree, William is continued as William Munt b. 1849 tree.

In 1910, three members of the Munt family occupied holdings for their market gardening business on the north and south sides of the High Street, in its centre, as shown on the map. 538 was owned by James Munt senior (1837-1922) widower (tree above), age73; 539 owned by Thomas Munt, age 33 (see James Munt b. 1837 tree, the youngest child of James Munt senior)., Site 484 which is now shops, was owned by James Munt, age 50 (see James Munt b. 1837 tree, the second oldest child of James Munt, senior). It is speculated that this may have been the main produce centre suggesting a pick-your-own approach? The two plots on the north are numbers 539, 538. Site 537 is the White Hart to the east, and Lynton House (535) is to the east of this.

James Munt senior, also owned and occupied the 20¾ acre Bullsdown.






William Munt, William John Munt often known just as John Munt, born in 1887, lost his life in the Great War. He served with the 11th battalion in the Royal Fusiliers, and died of his wounds on 2 November 1916 following the offensive on the Somme. His father, John Munt, was a farm labourer living in Littleworth. William John was living with his uncle in Wellingborough where they were both ironstone workers. William is remembered on page 74 of *They Were a Wall*.


Isaac Munt was born in Littleworth in 1895, son of John Munt, farm labourer and Fanny, nee Dover, both also born in Littleworth and living there in 1901 and 1911. Brother of William John Munt. In 1911 Isaac, too, was a farm labourer. There is an Isaac Munt listed in the WW1 Medal Rolls Index, as a Private in the Royal Warwickshire Regiment, No. 34779. When he married Celia Messenger in June 1931, he gave his occupation as engine driver. This was a second marriage for both of them as their previous partners were deceased. Of the thirty-one members of the wider Munt family living in Wheatley and listed in the 1921 Electoral Register, two were Isaac Munts, in Littleworth. Isaac Munt, b. 1895 died in 1979 and is buried in St Mary's churchyard.

He lived in Littleworth, probably No. 36. No descendants of Isaac and Celia Messenger are shown/known.








James Munt, 1837-1922, is referred to in the earlier tree as the owner of one of the High Street sites for the Munt market-gardening business. His youngest child, Thomas b. 1877, owned another of these sites. The site, now the parade of shops, was owned by the second son, James b. 1861, in the above tree

According to The High Street, Wheatley booklet, Herbert Munt (1869-1939) was the owner of Fairholme, 4 High Street in 1926 and Old Timbers, 6 High Street in 1929 and 1937.




Thomas Munt, Thomas Henry Munt born in 1883, lost his life in the Great War. He served with the 1/6 battalion in the Royal Warwickshire Regiment, and died of his wounds on 23 August 1916 following the offensive on the Somme. His father, George Munt, was a railway worker plate-layer and ganger. The family were living in Littleworth and, by 1901, Thomas had become a labourer. Thomas is remembered on page 73 of *They Were a Wall* alongside his nephew, Alfred James Munt, also killed in the Great War.





Edgar (ref I2428) is shown as having no issue. Both the 1921 and 1939 censuses have an Edgar b. 22/4/1887 living (1939) just south of Wheatley House with Elizabeth b. 15/6/1886, probably his mother although the birth date varies.

Ernest Alfred is on the 1921 census but not 1939. His and Mary's son, Henry Ernest Munt, slipped into a boiling copper on August 24 1925, scalded his leg and died 3 days later.

Ethel Mary Munt had an apparently bastard son Leslie Ewart Munt, born 1911 and shown on the 1921 census. Only female descendants. Joan and Sylvia are shown under Rolfe Munt, not Munt

Henry Munt, who was a shopkeeper in 1931, according to the Kelly Directory of that year, married Elizabeth Mary Shepherd in the late 1880s. Their second child, Mabel Munt was born in 1889. Mabel Munt married Philip Thomas Crook (born in Fulham and probably not related to the quarry owner John Crook) on 10 February 1912, with Henrietta Elizabeth Sophia Crook born in August 1912, and Mabel Ruth Elsie Crook born on 24 January 1915, with her mother dying in this

childbirth. Mabel Ruth Elsie Crook married William Henry Phipps on 5 August 1935. They had two

daughters Eileen and Jackie.

It is believed that Arkell was occupying part of the Station Road frontage in c. 1939, which was taken over by c.1955 by William Phipps.

Barclays was to move to a new building adjacent to the Merry Bells in 1960, when Phipps made a planning application for the entire site of 48 High Street and 2-4 Station Road seeking permission to demolish the 48 High Street frontage (leaving the substantive side and back walls), to remove the thatch, and to change the use from a bank to a shop.




Also, in archive record 0267, there are photos of Mr & Mrs Edgar Munt with their horses pulling a gypsy caravan, one outside the Old Post Office, 48 High Street at the 1935 Silver Jubilee. Horses usually pulled the dustcart, the rubbish from which was tipped into the village pit, a place remembered for the rats and the smell which was particularly bad when the rubbish was burnt. The horses were also used for hauling heavy loads for Cullum's timber yard.

Edgar was a chimney sweep in 1945. At some stage, he lived at 77 High Street, owned by Hubert Munt (not in our list) but mentioned on p. 36 of High Street book.






Andrew Munt joined the Machine Gun Corps in February 1917 and was drafted to France in March 1918. He was in action throughout the German offensive and Allied advance of 1918, and after the hostilities returned to England, being demobilised in February 1919. He held the General Service and Victory Medals. He had married Harriet Mary Tipping on 10 September 1916 (no issue shown). He died on 20 December 1944 aged 51 and is buried in St Mary's churchyard.



Alfred Munt, Private Alfred James Munt born in 1899, lost his life in the Great War. He enlisted in 1916, served in the Machine Gun Corps, and was killed on 7 June 1917 at the battle of Messines. The family were, at that time, living in Littleworth. He is remembered on page 73 of *They Were a Wall* alongside his nephew Thomas Munt, also killed in the Great War.

Baptised Richard James Munt in Wheatley Church on 1 November 1895, son of James Munt, gardener's labourer also born in Wheatley (in 1874) and Annie nee Jeffrey, born in Barton, Middlesex in 1869. The family were

living at 1 Shotover View, also listed as 11 Littleworth, in 1901 and 1911. Richard James was a market gardener, too, working for his parents on the land behind the house. He served as a Private in the Royal Field Artillery and possibly also in the Royal Flying Corps: the WW1 Medal Rolls Index shows him as a Driver, No. 170972.



Richard James Munt married Daisy Gertrude Heels in Wheatley. She was an upholsteress, born in Hackney London in 1893. He was listed on the Register of Electors in 1921 as living in Littleworth. He died on 20 January 1972. He lived in Littleworth, probably at No. 25. They had a son James Walter Munt b. 1923, seen when he was 14 and later with his aunt Daisy Lily Heels, his mother's sister.




Charles Munt tree b. 1875

In 1911, Charles Munt. with his wife Edith, occupied Clayton Cottage in Church Road. In 1930, Charles Munt bought the plot which is now 18, Old London Road and 33 London Road, selling off part in 1933 to Francis John Fane of Morland House and, later, Westland House, Holloway, Wheatley

Isaac Munt 1895 tree just records his marriage to Celia Messenger.

Archive notes which cannot be attributed to any of the Munts in this record:

Thomas Munt

Wood dealer in 1920 and 1931. Mr. Thomas Munt put up the present 75 and 77- He employed a local builder and the brick was obtained from Littleworth, the timber from Avery's and the stone was local. Thomas Munt owned cottages where the present numbers 69, 71, 75 now stand. Early in the century Hubert Munt owned No. 77 and Edgar Munt occupied it; ownership passed to Thomas Munt from 1934. Thomas occupied No. 75 until it was pulled down. The Munt brothers used to cut bundles of faggots and supplied the Oxford Colleges.

Elizabeth Munt

Elizabeth Munt, of Wheatley and a servant living with the Cooper family in 1861, married George Brown, widower from Stanton St John, on 28 November 1869. But there are no clues as to why the brook, which runs down the hill to the east of Ladder Hill and which never failed, may have been called Betty Brown's Spring, see record 2614.

Emma Munt

In 1925 Leslie Milne bought a plot for Archie Harding and his wife Emma Munt.

George Munt



Jim Munt


Lived at 73 High Street until it burned down in 1900. He was involved with the windmill restoration.






