

## White Hart

The old *White Hart*, Wheatley, 1822, drawn by James Buckler. The signboard names the landlord as George Crookes. Buckler also sketched the Manor House and 1795 chapel on Bell Lane. (*Bodleian Library, University of Oxford, MS Top Oxon a.69, fol. 588*)



It has been established from tythe maps that this was not on the site of the Language School. So, it may have been a precursor building on the site of the White Hart which is now (2018) Cinnamons. It is also possible that the current King & Queen may have taken this name briefly as there appears to be gap in the licensee names of this inn between 1813 and 1846.
