Comprehensive Education came to Wheatley in 1972, with the amalgamation of the Girls Grammar School and Wheatley Bilateral School, and became known as Wheatley Park School, Upper and Lower. Originally Lower School in Littleworth Road and Upper School at Holton until united on the Holton site.
