Rev. Halford Halford-Adcock

The Oxford Chronicle of 3 February 1922 records the death of the Rev. Halford Halford-Adcock, late Chaplain to H.M. Prisons, Lincoln, Durham, Portland and Holloway, aged 74.

Rev. Halford Adcock retired to Wheatley and lived at Greystones in the High Street. He was not officially attached to St Mary's Church but it is clear that he took services there and did other pastoral work around the village.

According to Crockford's in 1914 he was a graduate of Exeter College, Oxford. In 1914 his address was Greenhill Terrace, Weymouth, and in 1916-17 his address was Wheatley, Oxon.
