WHO LIVED AT SHOTOVER IN 1861?

The owner of the estate at the time of the 1861 census was Mr George Gammie, who described himself as a 'Landed Proprietor and Magistrate'. Mr Gammie (aged 41) was born in Aberdeenshire in 1820. He lived in 'Shotover Mansion House' with his wife, Ellen (aged 25) who was born in India, and his four young children: Grace Ellen, aged 4; Mary Maitland, aged 3; Emmeline Stuart, aged 2; and baby George Cecil, aged nine months. There were eighteen other households recorded within 'Shotover' and these included the farms and houses of the estate workers.
