Notes

- 1. In 1834, these holdings were valued at £275 x 30 = £8,250. But, this was for the purpose of transfer from father to son.
- 2. Rents in this period were typically 30/- per acre, so the values are reasonable
- 3. Plan 20, Farm Close is noted as a meadow. The plan shows a stream running through it from a spring to the south and flowing into the stream south of the High Street.
- 4. Plan 34, Crown Close, is nowhere near the Crown
- 5. Plan 12, what-is-now Templar's Close was then Temple Close.
- 6. Plan 31 is the non-village green on which there are now houses
- 7. Plan 32 is the yard and large barn in High Street opposite the Manor
- 8. Plan 33 (Sturges' garden) is at the end of Kiln Lane where it meets Westfield Road.
- 9. It is thought that Groves bought plots 5, 6, 11, 20-29, 30, and 34. Others shown with an X on p.107 (Bygone Wheatley) were already owned by him. Pages 107-108 will need a lot of changes!
- 10. In 1846, Chillingworth bought plots 3-10.
- 11. The Racks, plots 12-18 were bought by A. N. Other, as were 19 (Crown Rickyard) and 31 (Little Green).
- 12. The Manor House and The Breach were unsold until 1851 when sold to the Diocese
