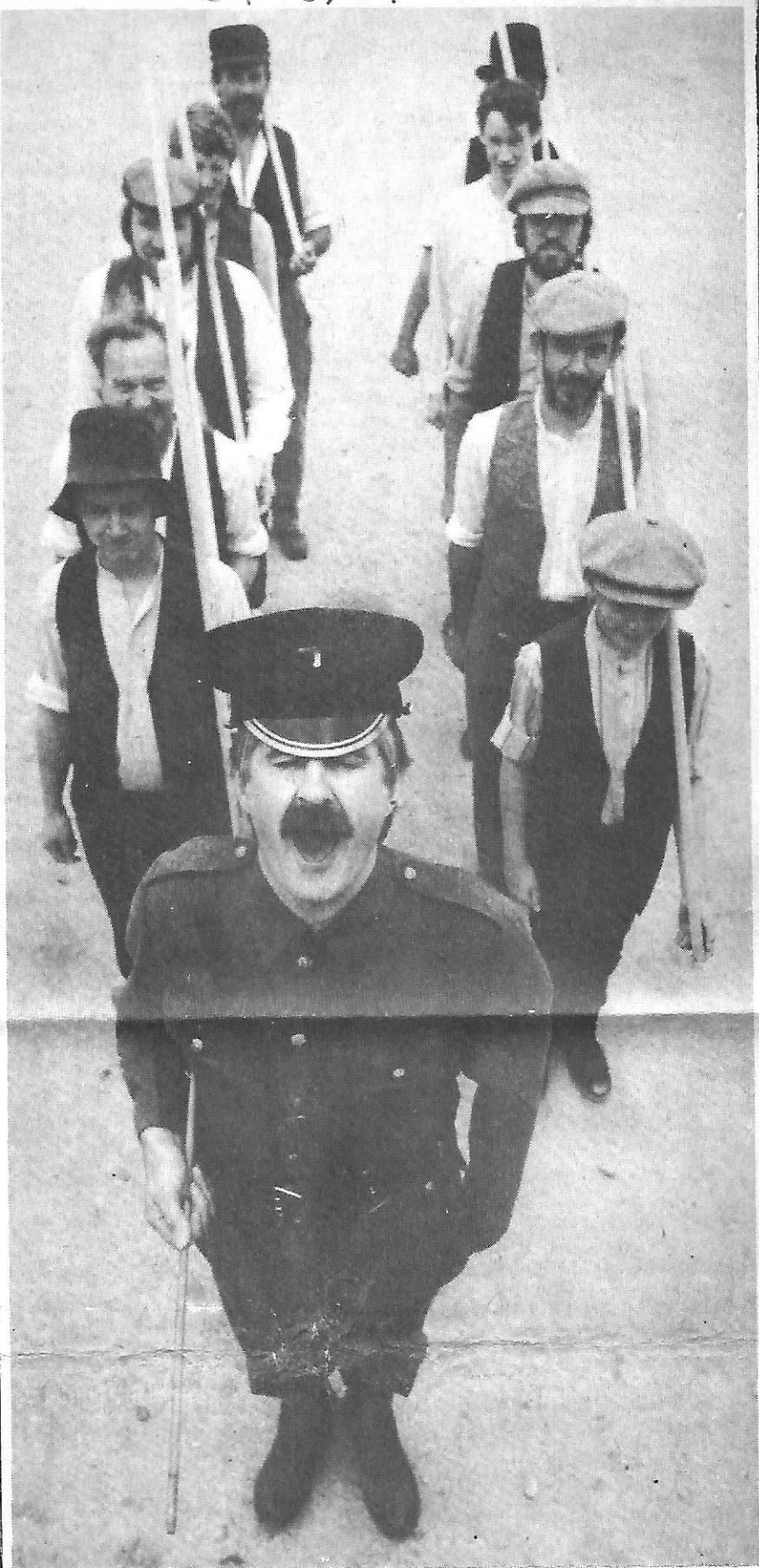


Atten... shun!

Recruiting Sergeant John Wilson is rounding up farmworkers in the village during the First World War.

Wheatley playwright Mick Jones has chosen the date 1916 to set the action for the Players' latest production, *The Soldiers Have Taken Our Horses Away*.

A 150-strong cast of actors and musicians have been on rehearsal drill in preparation for performances from May 25 to 27 at Wheatley Primary School.

Memories of villagers who recalled life in Wheatley almost 70 years ago have been used during the two years of research which went into compiling the play.
