

WHEATLEY WOMEN'S INSTITUTE  
CENTENARY WALL HANGING 1919 – 2019

In 2018 Craft Club started the idea of creating a wall hanging to celebrate our Centenary (1919 – 2019) with the idea of visually representing our WI in 2019, through seasonal and annual activities involving fun, friendship and education.

The hanging shows our village hall, The Merry Bells, where meetings are generally held, together with a photo of members taken in the summer of 2019 and printed on fabric.

Techniques included applique, crochet, embroidery, cross stitch, knitting, fabric painting, patchwork and fabric printing. The four corners show logos for the National Federation of Women's Institute, the Oxfordshire Federation of Womens' Institute, the Fritillary Group and Wheatley W.I.

One hundred buttons were donated by and sewn on by all Wheatley WI members.

The names of the Craft Club members who created the hanging between 2018 and 2021 (delayed owing to the Covid pandemic) are shown on the reverse of the hanging.
